CLINICAL

- Secure IV access x 2 (may include central line)
- Gastric tube
- Urinary catheter
- A-line
- Propofol in 50ml syringe sufficient for >2hrs
- Opioid infusion sufficient for >2hrs (Fentanyl 50mcg/ml (neat) preferred)
- If on inotropes / vasopressor, sufficient for >2hrs
- Blood available if actively bleeding or Hb <80
- Post-intubation CXR available for review (if not taken, please arrange CXR now)
- ABG within 1hr of team's arrival please
- If tracheostomy, safety box and supply of spare inner cannulas

NON-CLINICAL

- Photocopy of all relevant hospital notes
- Print out of electronic patient record (discharge summary)
- Images available to destination hospital
- Number for key contact at destination hospital
- Exact location to go to at destination hospital
- Next-of-kin informed
- Next-of-kin contact details in notes
